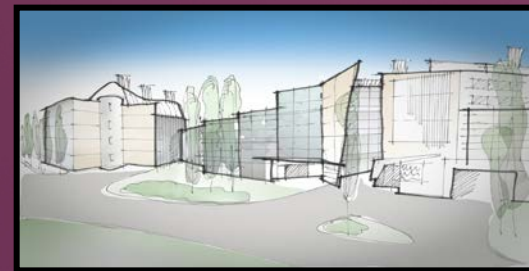

The Centre for CSG

The Centre for (*research into*) Coal Seam Gas is an integral part of the University of Queensland and SMI

- Funding (so far, over 5 years)
 - \$15 million Industry (QGC, Santos, Arrow). \$5 million, UQ.
- Governance
 - *Advisory* Board: UQ (Chair), Industry and Qld Regulator
 - Final Research Decisions – UQ
 - Research Ethics, Policies & Procedures - UQ
- Researchers
 - UQ & partnering research institutions (e.g. CSIRO)

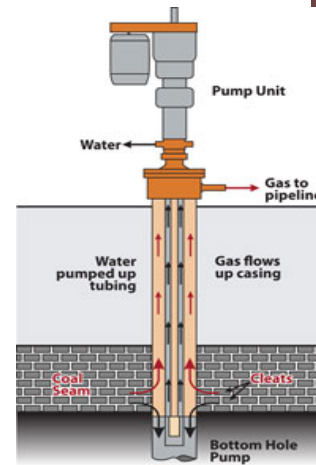

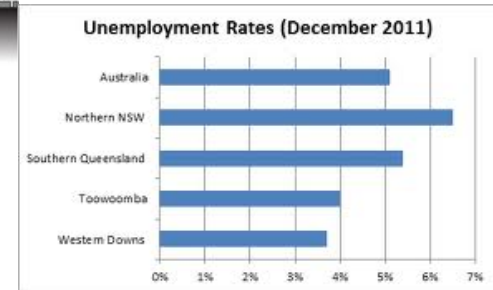

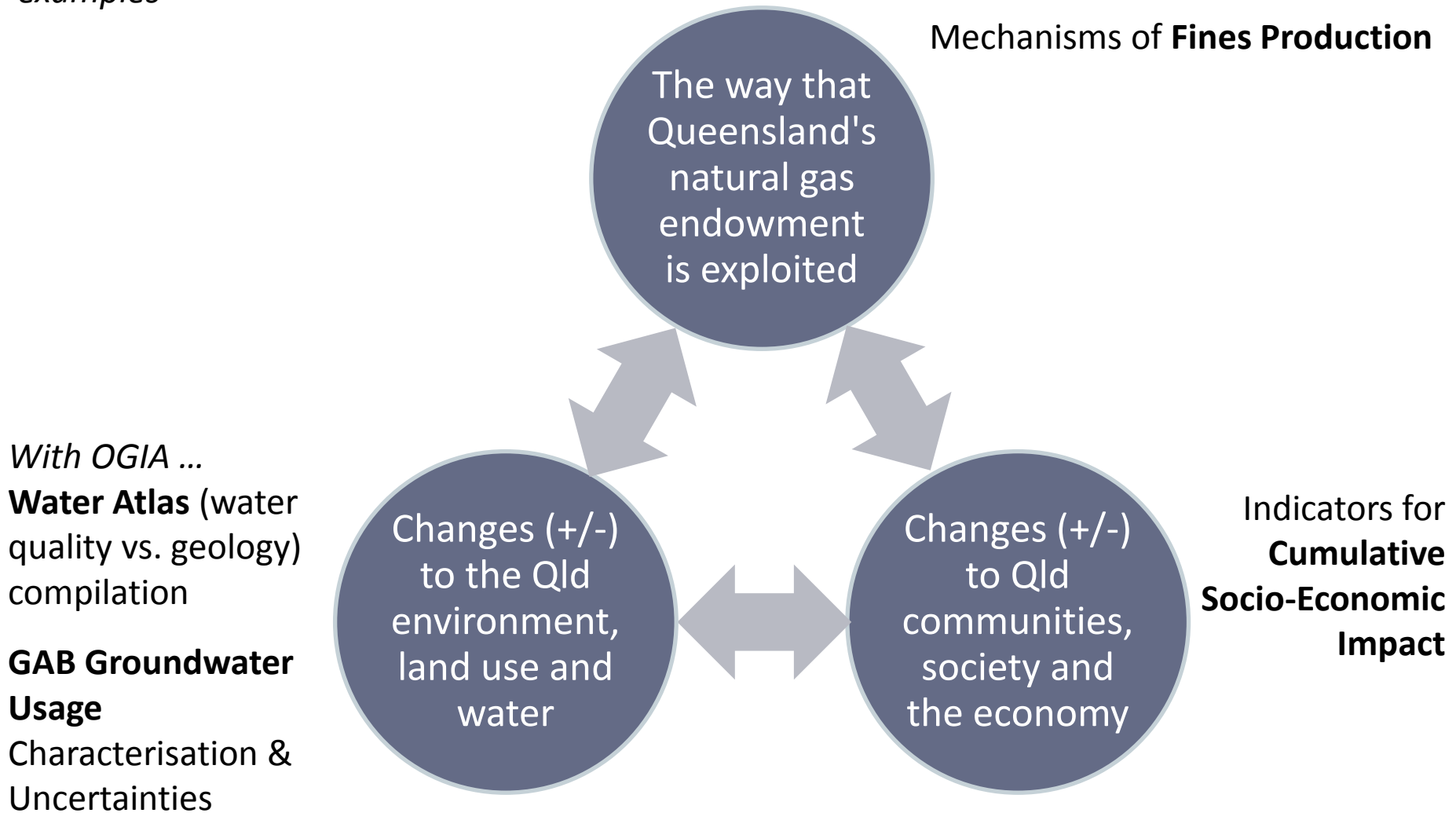
