- Identifies pests declared under WDRRC Local Law

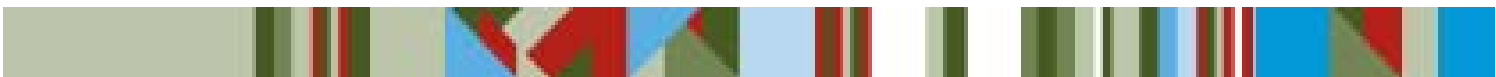

How Do We Achieve This?

- 8 Rural Service Officers
- NRM Officer
- Wild Dog Trapper – also maintains Wild Dog Check Fences
- 2 contracted Wild Dog Trapper
- Wild Dog Baiting Program – twice yearly
- Scalp Bounty
- Provision of Manufactured baits and 1080 to grain

How Do We Achieve This?

- Wandoan Cattle dip and Spray Station
- Washdown Facilities
 - 2 Major – Wandoan and Chinchilla. Soon to be a Dalby facility
 - Smaller Washdown sites within each Service Centre.
 - Administer Permits for Temporary Washdown locations across the region.

Issues

- In the past:
 - Land Access
 - Participation in Pest and Weed Control Programs
- Due to – Lack of consultation over the years
- Better communication and information sharing between council and industry groups now.

Issues

- Current and Continuing:
 - Weed Seed Spread
 - The facilities are available ---- third party contractors
 - Temporary Washdown
 - We know that it happens.
 - 90% of time – don't know where it occurs.

Needs and Expectations

- CONSISTENCY and LINKAGES
- Consistency = more participation in *appropriate* prevention and control of Pest Animals and Weeds
- Linkages = Partnerships with landholders, industry groups and other agencies in developing action plans
 - Extra resourcing more accessible and improved consistency across boundaries more achievable;.
